FSM policy for sixth formers

- Students aged 16, 17 or 18 can claim free school meals if they or their parents are in receipt of one or more of the following benefits:
 - o Income support
 - o Income based jobseekers allowance
 - o Income related employment and support allowance (ESA)
 - o Support under part VI of the immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 - o The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
 - Child Tax Credit (provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and do not have an annual gross income of more than £16,190.
 - o Working Tax Credit Run On
 - o Universal Credit
- Applications need to be made on a yearly basis by completion of the application form.
- Students aged 19 are only entitled to a free school meal if they have an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP)
