**Explain what it is** the evidence you have chosen shows us (in relation to the question).

### Context

How do the circumstances affect how the quote being used is received?

# nfer

What conclusions can you make about what the writer is trying to do?



# Link

How does this paragraph link to the question or how does this paragraph link to the next?
