**Re: Big Bang Fair**

A trip has been arranged for all Year 9 students to visit the Big Bang Fair which is being held at the Silverstone circuit in conjunction with the University of Northampton on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2018. The Big Bang Fair is an award-winning combination of exciting interactive workshops, exhibits and careers information from STEM professionals. Below is a note from Northampton University explaining their tracking system for the outreach events that they run. To participate the University needs your consent to keep a record that your child has attended.

***The University of Northampton is part of HEAT (Higher Education Access Tracker), a National HE tracking system currently working with over 50 University's. HEAT tracks students participation in outreach activities and builds evidence of the impact of schools engagement activities on their progression into FE and HE. Like all Universities, we require attendance data of all young people participating in our outreach programmes to meet health and safety requirements and for monitoring purposes only. Individuals details are kept anonymous and we adhere to strict guidelines on data protection.***

***Please return the permission slip overleaf to school to confirm that you give consent for the University to keep a record that your child has attended this, and future, ASPIRE activities. Opting out will not affect your child's participation in the activity, but does mean that the University cannot track their participation in outreach activities to evidence future student achievement and prove the value of ASPIRE activities to raise aspirations of young people.***

There is no cost for this trip. Students will travel by bus, leaving school at 9.00am and will return to school for Period 5. Students will need to have breakfast before arriving at school and will require a packed lunch for the day. Please complete the consent form and reply slip below and return to school before Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2018. All students are required to wear full school uniform and will be reminded that normal school expectations in regards to behaviour and conduct will apply during this trip.
