### **Year 10 Careers Experience**

During assembly today, we have explained our plans for all Year 10 students to go out for a week to experience the world of work. Students have the opportunity to arrange their own placements at any time during this academic year with a company of their choosing. Over the next few weeks students will have initial discussions with their form tutors and with specialist staff from "Timely Advice" who provide independent careers information.
