# **OCTOBER UPDATE LETTER 2017**

Dear Parent/Carer

This update letter marks the conclusion of a highly successful term at Corby Technical School. At the start of term, we had the pleasure of welcoming back our existing students as well as our newly expanded cohort of 150 Year 7 students. We are delighted at how well these students have settled into our school. They have come to us with excellent attitudes towards their studies and are upholding the values of our school well. We have also opened our first Sixth Form with a small cohort of Year 12 students. They are relishing in our specific technical offer where we have courses running such as Maths, Computer Science, Engineering, and Physics. The students have risen to the level of challenge that Post-16 study brings. In addition to their academic studies all students in Year 12 are now first-aid trained and their extra-curricular work next term will now focus on bespoke work experience and a peer mentoring scheme for lower school students. We will be holding an open event for prospective Sixth Form students on November 9<sup>th</sup> at 6.00pm.

Our extra-curricular provision this term has seen students attend a theatre trip to the West End to see Aladdin, an author visit to a local school, and a weekend activity residential to Wales. Our theatre trip proved to be extremely popular so we do intend to organise another trip later on this year. Year 7 have all taken part in our tailor-made activity week where they have been to Corby swimming pool, the cinema, kayaked at Rutland Water as well as several in-house activities such as our infamous Master Chef. Thank you to those parents/carers who attended our residential information evenings. We still have a few places remaining for the Year 8 residential to France. If you would still like your child to attend then please pay the deposit via Wisepay to secure the place. If places are full for either residential we will hold a waiting list so please do contact the school as we may be able to increase the numbers on the trip if we have the demand.

The improvements we have been making to our school building and grounds are near completion. The new block opened in September and has brought additional facilities such as the drama studio, lecture theatre and high-quality computing facilities. Our refurbishment of the existing top-floor is almost complete and will be opening on the first Monday back after our break. This will offer two new Art and Design rooms, an improved Design and Technology studio and four new Science laboratories.

I would like to thank all our parents for their support over this term. On the reverse side of this letter you will find other useful information and key dates for this academic year.
