R.E. 'Curious Incident' – GCSE – Theatre Visit

As part of the GCSE Drama course students are required to see a theatrical production of their chosen production text – this is essential as students are required to write a response to this production in the GCSE examination. The Drama department has secured tickets for the GCSE Drama students to see a matinee performance of 'The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time' at Aylesbury Waterside Theatre on Thursday 9th February.
