Dear Student,

We hope that you are delighted with the results that you have received today and that you are able to continue onto your intended destination or career path. As a school we are here to support you with your next steps throughout today and for as long as you need us after today! Below we have detailed some information that you may wish to review if you decide to take a different route to what you had originally planned. There are a number of options that we can consider which are highlighted below:

University Admissions

If you have applied to university, you can login to the UCAS Hub to check to see if you have been placed onto your firm or insurance choice. If you have been successful in securing a place, there is nothing you need to do and your university will be in touch with further details. It is important you check the UCAS Hub carefully as sometimes universities may accept student's even when the offer hasn't been quite met.

If you haven't been accepted onto your firm of insurance course (or if you've done better than you thought and would like to consider University or apply for a different one!), there is an extensive offer of courses through the UCAS clearing process. If you require any support with this process, see Miss Muckett or Miss Jenkins. You can make use of computers in the DT study area if you need to access the clearing website to see what's on offer. The UCAS clearing website can be found [here](#) or you can scan the QR code in the bottom corner of this letter for more information. The UCAS clearing website will show you the courses on offer and you will need to contact the universities directly to see if they can offer you a place.

Checks and Remarks

The school has checked your overall score for each qualification against the released grade boundaries. If you are very close to a grade boundary, you will have been identified and will have a permission form in your results envelope for you to consent to having your grade checked. If you are unsure if you should have been considered for this, contact the exams team (exams@corbytechnicalschool.org). In order to apply for a review of your mark, you will need to sign a form to give permission for this if you submit a request for review, it is really important that you make your university aware that this has been submitted and how far away you are from the grade boundary. Universities may wait for the results of a review to complete but this is at their discretion. All reviews will be submitted as part of the exam boards priority service to ensure these are returned as soon as possible (within 15 days maximum). You will not be able to submit an independent request for review and this can only be done through the school.

Before you leave today, it is important that you ensure that your sign-off sheet is completed and that this is handed in before you leave the school. Although you might not have a full understanding of your next steps, it's important that we have as much detail as possible. We may be in touch to get further information from you in the near future as your position becomes clearer.
