Revision activity Number 1	<p>Speaking Exam preparation:</p> <p>In order to learn the answers that you have prepared in your speaking booklet you can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chunk the paragraph into small sections to learn a bit at a time.</li> <li>• Take out words until you can say it without any words at all or write the first letter of each word and try to say the text.</li> <li>• Read it out loud into Google Translate by clicking on the microphone to record, or you can type/copy and paste the text into the box. (You can take a picture of it, save it as a file and then use <a href="http://www.onlineocr.net">www.onlineocr.net</a> to convert it to an editable text that you can copy and paste.) Once the text is in the box, you can click the speaker icon to hear it read out to you. You can use this to repeat what has just been said, record the audio onto your phone so that you can listen to it and try to say it first then check.</li> </ul>

Revision activity Number 2	<p>Learning vocabulary</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Using your vocabulary booklet cover a section of the Spanish and look at the English. If you can write the word in Spanish without looking you know that word and can move on to the next one. When you come to a word that you don't know, make a flashcard by writing the Spanish word on one side and the English translation on the other. When you have found 5 to 6 words that you need to learn stop. Look at the words in English or get someone to test you. Do this at least once every day until you know them. Then go and find another 6 words from your vocab list and repeat the process. Remember to go back now and then to check the first words you found to make sure that you still know them.</li> <li>• Use <a href="http://quizlet.com">quizlet.com</a> to play games and revise vocabulary online</li> </ul>
