Purpose of job

Objectives

The teacher of Physical Education will be:

- responsible for the academic outcomes of the students they teach
- able to deliver high quality teaching along with high expectations
- expected to develop exemplary practice, which supports the ethos, values and vision and contributes to the overall life and work of the school
- expected to promote and develop social, moral and physical aptitudes in their students, and to provide advice and guidance where necessary

Core Purpose

The main responsibilities for the Teacher of Physical Education are to:

- take responsibility and be accountable for student attainment and achievement, by tracking student progress and supporting individual pupils' learning needs.
- embrace the technical focus of the school by developing opportunities within the curriculum to promote industry links.
- forge appropriate and mutually beneficial links with local Sports facilities and coaches to enhance the pupil skill base and provide encouragement for pupils in their sporting development.
- manage the contribution to extra-curricular sports activities, including coaching of school teams and the admission of pupils to County and District sporting events where appropriate.
- write risk assessments for all P.E. activities and maintain a record of all incidents that occur in P.E. lessons, review all such incidents and where appropriate modify risk assessments.
- develop comprehensive schemes of work and learning materials, which include a range of teaching and learning styles providing a rich experience for students, and incorporate a variety of assessment methods at key points to enable accurate judgements on student progress.
- champion best practice in this area, demonstrating teaching skills and leadership qualities necessary to command respect, and encourage commitment to raising standards.

Collegiate Responsibility

In addition to the specific responsibilities of this post, every member of staff at Corby Technical School will commit to :

- ✓ *Providing a courteous and efficient service to students at all time*
- ✓ *Using their influence with other staff and students to promote high standards of behaviour and order within the school*
