

Year 10 Examination summary

For students and parent/carers 2024

Candidate name - Candidates must use their full legal name on all exam papers.

Candidate number – All students will be given a 4-digit candidate number which will be displayed on a card on their exam desk. It is important this number is written on all exam papers you sit.

Equipment – It is your responsibility to bring all your own equipment and resources to the exams. Borrowing from other candidates is **NOT** allowed in the exam. *You should bring your equipment in a clear pencil case or plastic bag.*

Equipment you are required to bring to every exam:

- > 2 black pens
- ➤ 2 HB pencils
- ≻ Ruler
- ➤ Pencil sharpener
- ≻ Rubber

Items to be brought to certain exams.

- ≻ Compass
- ➤ Protractor
- ➤ Calculator
- ➤ Coloured Pencils

Scrap paper and revision notes **must not** be taken into the exam room.

Only a transparent water bottle, with no labels and no bigger than 500ml can be brought into the exam room.

Before exam – You will be required to sit in the restaurant behind the letter relating to your seat ready to walk in silence row by row when instructed.

Conduct during the exam – As soon as you enter the exam room you are under exam conditions. You must not communicate or turn around.

You must raise your hand for assistance and wait for an invigilator.

Listen carefully to instructions and notices that are read out by invigilators. Before you start check you have the correct paper and read through the instructions on the front of the paper before starting the exam.

End of exam – If you finish before the time allowed for the exam, carefully check your answers. Make sure your name and candidate number are on every piece of paper used. At the end of the exam all work must be handed in to the invigilator before you can leave.

In the event of a fire drill or emergency you must exit in complete silence.

Exam tips:

- ➤ Go to the toilet before the exam.
- ➤ Have a good night sleep and eat a good breakfast.
