Traditionally letters were the preferred way in which a school would communicate with parents, however at Corby Technical School we use a number of different ways to communicate particularly e-mail and text messaging. Both of these services are vital in communicating efficiently and effectively with you.

- **Email**: School communicates with you using your primary email address. This is also the e-mail you should use to register with Wisepay. This allows us to provide you with information such as school events and sporting fixtures.
- **Text Messages**: School communicates with you using the mobile telephone number you provide on your Data Collection Sheet. School uses the text messaging service on our SIMS Management information system to send you urgent messages, reminders for upcoming events and absence notifications.
- **School Website**: Letters and diary dates are available on our website, please be aware that diary dates may change and you should check regularly for any updates.
- Twitter: Updates and information are shared @CTSCorby
