## **Sixth Form Dress Code Expectations**

All students will adhere to the Sixth Form Business Wear Policy at all times, as detailed below:

Phones, MP3 players and headphones must never be visible around the school. They are only permitted in the Library, to listen to music during private study. If found outside of this area they will be confiscated and taken to the school office for collection at the end of the day.

The Sixth Form dress code is smart business attire. Students in Years 12 and 13 are expected to meet the professional business wear expectations as follows:

Jeans, cord trousers, and training shoes are not part of the school uniform and should not be worn. Belts, if worn, should be plain, black with no studs or other

adornments. Tops should not be off the shoulder and skirts and dresses not excessively tight or short. Trousers should be full length.

Oversized jumpers or cardigans are not permitted.

It is expected that every student starting at Corby Technical School Sixth Form will adhere to this policy.

All Sixth Form students are expected to wear smart business dress to create a good impression, i.e. as if they were attending an interview.

## **Dressed Inappropriately?**

A first warning will be given by the Form Tutor on the first occasion that mode of dress is not fit for school. You would need to rectify for the next day.

A second incidence will result in parents being contacted by the tutor via email.

Final warning - Form tutors contact home to inform parents/carers. A parental meeting will be arranged.

If necessary, students will be sent home to change into suitable clothing.

If in doubt about an item of clothing you should consult your Form Tutor. The final decision on suitability of dress rests with the Head of Sixth Form. If you are in breach of this dress code, you will be sent home – if in doubt it is probably unacceptable.
