Dear Parent/Carer,

I am pleased to inform you that your child has been asked to participate in our Charity Showcase on **Monday 19th December**. The performance will take place between **5.30pm and 6.30pm** and the audience will be admitted approximately 15 minutes before the start of the show.

We will also be running a **rehearsal on the same day straight after school**. Students will therefore need to stay through from the end of school until the concert. It is crucial that everyone taking part is at that rehearsal, so that they know where to sit and what to do for the performances. Students will be provided with some light refreshments at school but please feel free to provide your child with a packed lunch if you would like them to eat more substantially in the break in between the rehearsal and the performance. Students will be registered for the rehearsal on Edulink. They have already been added to the registers for this, so there is no need for them to sign up.

Students who are performing are to wear black trousers and shoes, and a plain black top (if they don't have a plain black top, their school PE shirt is fine). They may wear Christmas accessories (e.g. hats, head bands or tinsel) if they wish to.

Each performer has been allocated three tickets for the audience. Tickets are free of charge, but there will be a charity bucket collecting for Shelter on the door, so please bring cash with you if you would like to contribute. We will be playing/singing well known Christmas tunes and showcasing some drama and dance performances, and it will be a great way to get you and your family into the Christmas spirit. If you would like to join us, **please reserve your ticket(s) on the Parents' Evening system** if you wish to bring more guests, please contact enquiries@corbytechnicalschool.org and they will add you to a waiting list and advise nearer the time if there are any spare seats you can be allocated.
