

## A Level Entry Requirements 2019

### Route 1: Entry onto A levels/AS levels

- The school entry requirements for all applicants will be the same and are: a minimum of five higher grade GCSE results (grades A\* to C/grades 9 to 5) including GCSE English Language at grade A\* to C/9 to 5 and GCSE Mathematics at grade A\* to C/9 to 5.
- In order to study individual subjects the specified GCSE entry grade criteria for each respective subject, as below.

### Route 2: Combination route – Vocational plus A/AS levels

- The school entry requirements for all applicants, external or internal, will be the same and are: a minimum of four higher grade GCSE results (grades A\* to C/grades 9 to 5) including at least one of GCSE English Language at grade A\* to C/9 to 5 or GCSE Mathematics at grade A\* to C/9 to 5. Students will be expected to retake the lower of the Maths or English GCSE as part of this offer.
- In order to study individual subjects the specified GCSE entry grade criteria for each respective subject, as below.

Entry to individual courses is dependent on meeting the subject specific requirements outlined below.

Subject	Requirements
<b>Art</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Art if studied or a portfolio of work to be assessed
<b>Biology</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Biology and another single science, or Grade 7 or above in Core and Additional Science. (NB 6 grades must be achieved in all examination components)
<b>Business</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Business if studied or 360 points if not studied
<b>Business Applied General</b>	330 Points
<b>Chemistry</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Chemistry and another single science, or Grade 7 or above in Core and Additional Science. (NB 6 grades must be achieved in all examination components)
<b>Computer Science</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Computer Studies if studied or 6 or above in GCSE Maths if not studied
<b>Dance</b>	Grade 5 or above in GCSE Dance and prior Dance experience essential
<b>DT Product Design</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Product Design / Textiles
<b>Engineering</b>	Grade 6 or above in Maths and Physics or Combined Science, Grade 5 in DT
<b>English Language</b>	Grade 7 or above in GCSE English Language or Grade 6 in both GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature
<b>English Literature</b>	Grade 7 or above in GCSE English Literature or Grade 6 in both GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature
<b>French</b>	Grade 6 or above GCSE French
<b>Geography</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Geography if studied or 360

	points if not studied
<b>Health and Social Care Applied General</b>	330 points
<b>History</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE History if studied or 360 points if not studied
<b>ICT Applied General</b>	Grade 5 or above in GCSE ICT or at least a Pass in a Level 2 IT course or 330 points
<b>Media</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Media if studied or 360 points if not studied
<b>Maths</b>	Grade 7 or above in GCSE Mathematics
<b>Further Maths</b>	Grade 8 or above in GCSE Mathematics
<b>Music</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Music or Grade 5 theory, and at least Grade 5 on main instrument
<b>Sociology</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Sociology if studied or Grade 6 or above in English Language and 360 points if not studied
<b>Sport Applied General</b>	Grade 5 or above in GCSE PE and Grade 5 or above in GCSE Science and a commitment to sports or physical activities outside core PE
<b>Photography</b>	Grade 6 or above in a GCSE Arts subject or a portfolio of work to be assessed
<b>Physics</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Physics and another single science, or Grade 7 or above in Core and Additional Science. (NB 6 grades must be achieved in all examination components)
<b>Psychology</b>	Grade B or above in GCSE Psychology if studied or 360 points if not studied
<b>Religious Studies</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Religious Education. 360 points if not studied
<b>Spanish</b>	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Spanish
