**Re: Christmas at Corby Technical School**

I am writing to you to update you on the Christmas Celebrations which will take place at Corby Technical School.

Christmas Dinner:

Christmas dinner for students and staff will be held on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> December. Students can wear normal clothes on this day including a Christmas jumper if they wish too. Following lunch there will be Christmas activities for all students in Years 7-11. The choices for Christmas Lunch are listed below.

- Main Meal - Christmas Lunch – Turkey with all the trimmings.
- Main Meal - Vegetarian Option – Vegetable wellington served with butternut squash sauce
- Snack Meal – Turkey and Vegetable Soup with homemade bread.
- Snack Meal – Christmas dinner in a Bap (Turkey, stuffing, pigs in blankets).

Please ensure there are sufficient funds on your child's Wisepay account if they are having Christmas Lunch. Students who do not wish to have one of the options above will need to bring a packed lunch on the day. **ALL** students will be expected in school on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> December. May we remind you that Friday 21<sup>st</sup> December is a staff training day so school will be closed to students.

Christmas Showcase:

This year we will hold a Christmas Showcase, this will take place on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> December in the George Weston Theatre from 6.30pm to 8.00pm. Tickets for the show will be available from Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December from the school reception. We are excited to showcase the talents of our students to all parents and carers. We are expecting a high turnout and will expect all students who are in the audience to be accompanied by a responsible adult. Students who attend without an accompanying adult will not be allowed entry to the show. Last year we supported Corby Food Bank who are always in need of supplies. Tickets for the Showcase can be "purchased" with a food donation for Corby Food Bank. A list of qualifying foods is attached overleaf. We would ask that all donations are unopened and well within their sell by/use by date. Any items that are opened or past their sell by/use by date cannot be accepted in exchange for a ticket.
