School Events

The end of this term is always a busy one as we lead into the Christmas break. We would like to share with you some important notices and events.

End of term closure:

School will close for the Christmas break on **Thursday 21st December at 3.00pm** with all students returning to school on **Monday 8th January**. Please note all students will finish at 3.00pm including Year 11.

Non-uniform day and Christmas dinner:

On our last day of term Thursday 21st December, students will have a non-uniform day. At this festive time, students might like to wear Christmas themed clothing such as a Christmas jumper. Please ensure your child dresses appropriately for the school day i.e. no shorts, midriff baring shirts or short skirts and your child has their swipe card as they will need this to register for school and to purchase breakfast and/or lunch.

Christmas dinner for students and staff will also be held on Thursday 21st December. Each year, students have very much enjoyed celebrating together with their friends, teachers and other staff. The cost of the Christmas meal is our usual price of **£3.19**. A menu is attached for your information.
