### **Year 13 Additional Examination Support:**

I hope this letter finds you well. As we approach the final stretch of the academic year, I wanted to extend an invitation to our Year 13 students for additional supervised study sessions over the next term and over the Easter holidays. At Corby Technical School, we understand the importance of providing our students with every opportunity to excel academically. With upcoming examinations and assessments, we believe that these additional sessions will provide valuable support and guidance to ensure our students are fully prepared and confident in their abilities.

### **Supervised Study:**

Some of our students prefer to undertake their independent study in school, so to meet this need, we have created additional opportunities for this. These sessions will provide a conducive environment for focused revision and independent study. Our dedicated staff will be on hand to offer assistance, clarify doubts, and provide encouragement as our students work towards their academic goals. We firmly believe that these additional sessions will complement our existing curriculum and support our students in achieving their full potential. By participating in these sessions, students will not only strengthen their subject knowledge but also develop essential study skills and habits that will serve them well in their future academic endeavours.

During term time, the school will continue to be open for year 13 students from 8.00am to 8.30am and after school from 4.00pm to 5.00pm on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, and from 3.00pm to 4.00pm on Friday.

### **Easter Holiday Year 13 study sessions:**

The school will be open each day apart from the Bank Holiday during the Easter holidays to provide a space in which students can revise and complete work. The facilities will be available between 9.00am and 3.00pm when students will be able to use computers and there will be staff on hand to support if required. In addition, there are a few study sessions being offered, the details of which are listed below. Students will need to sign in and out and supervision will be on an informal basis. Students do not need to wear formal clothes in line with our sixth form dress policy during the holiday sessions. The normal behaviour and safety expectations apply and will need to remain in the designated workspaces as we will have maintenance work taking place in other areas of the school. Students may bring food and drink to consume in school during this time if they wish, as our restaurant will not be in service.

These sessions will offer extra support and guidance with their programmes of study. It would be expected that a student attends a whole session where possible, although it is understandable that they may attend part of a session if there is a previous commitment.
