## Year 10 June Mock Examinations

Dear Parents/Carers,

Further to our letter dated 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2024, this is a quick reminder that as part of our ongoing assessment of students, we are now at the stage of further assessments in Year 10 with a full Mock Exam Programme to feed into our monitoring of progress and the next steps that need to be taken to ensure excellent outcomes for all.

Students are sitting assessments in nearly all subjects which reflect those they will complete during year 11. These are outlined in the attached document and can also be found on our website page [here](#) for Year 10 Exams.

Please also be aware that students will be sitting a Spanish speaking assessment in Weeks 4 and 5 of Term 6. Personalised timetables will be created by the Spanish department to inform students of the time and day of their assessment.

In light of the above and to ensure that Year 10 are ready for the exams, students had a run through of the examination preparation process. This included where to put their bags, which row to sit in according to the seating plan and most importantly to remind them of the exam expectations. Students were reminded that examination halls are silent spaces, and that they are not allowed to bring in any unauthorised items including phones, watches of any kind or any written materials. Our invigilators will be conducting these exams with the same routines and expectations as the formal GCSE examinations to help to prepare students for this.
