Re: Years 7-10 Sports Day

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to invite you to attend our Annual Sports Day which has been scheduled to take place on Thursday 11th July for students in Year 7-10. The event will take place at school with the main athletics events taking place on the school field where you will have the opportunity to watch your child compete against other students within their year group. There are a number of events taking place which you will see on the reverse side of this letter. The events taking place on the school field that you will be able to observe are track events, field events and Tug of War. Below is a summary of the times:

When parents/carers arrive, you will be directed to a designated area on the school field. Please note for safety reasons, parents and carers will be expected to remain in the designated zone and therefore you will not be able to interact with your child directly during the event. Toilets will be available and there will be disabled/pram access. In terms of photography on the day for consent purposes we would ask that parents/carers only take pictures of their child/children only.

To support the PE department with the organisation of the event, all students must arrive to school in their full CTS PE Kit, including sensible trainers. This will ensure all students are prepared to compete in their events safely and on time.

Please ensure students bring in non-fizzy drinks with them, to keep themselves hydrated throughout the event. Students will have access to water throughout the day if they wish to fill up their water bottles. It is also advised that if the weather is hot that your child brings sun cream with them. Break and lunch will be as normal and each year group will be able to go to the restaurant to collect their food in allocated slots. We will be selling ice lollies as an additional item at the price of 20p.

If the weather on the day is too wet for students to compete safely, we will contact parents/carers to inform them if we have to cancel the event.

We look forward to a fantastic day and seeing the students compete together.
