Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 10 and 11 Drama - Back to the Future The Musical Trip

We are excited to inform you that we have arranged an educational trip for our students to see a matinee performance of Back to the Future The Musical at the Adelphi Theatre in London. This trip provides a wonderful opportunity for students to experience live theatre and enjoy a world-class production that brings together elements of storytelling, music, and technical artistry and will allow students to further their studies in their GCSE Music and/or Drama by exploring 2 area of studies for music students; conventions of pop and film music and explore all design and technical aspects of the Drama course from one of the most technologically designed theatre shows currently running in the West End.

The trip will take place on Thursday 23rd January 2025 and the cost for the theatre ticket and coach will be £58. We will depart from school at 9.00am to view the matinee performance and will return to Corby Technical School at approximately 8.00pm. Students should arrive at school no later than 8.40am. Students will require a packed lunch for the day or they will be able to purchase food at Leicester Square or Covent Garden as we will visit both on the day. The food outlets may be expensive and many no longer accept cash payments so please bear this in mind.

There will also be an opportunity to purchase refreshments and musical gifts during the interval, so students may wish to bring a small amount of spending money. We expect to return by 8.00pm, but we will keep you updated if there are any significant delays via our Social Media account.

To secure your child's place on the trip, please make an initial deposit of £10 on or before Monday 9th December 2024 via WisePay. We have a limited number of seats available, so early responses will help secure your child's place on this trip. The remainder of the payment will be due on or before Friday 10th January 2025. We understand that the cost of the trip may be a concern for some families. Our school is committed to ensuring that every student has the opportunity to participate, regardless of financial circumstances. If the cost presents a challenge, we encourage you to reach out to us confidentially for financial assistance.
