**Re: Year 8 and 9 Theatre trip**

Dear Parents/Carers

We are delighted to inform you that Year 8 and 9 students studying Drama have been invited to attend a production of &Juliet at The Milton Keynes Theatre on 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2025. The total cost for the trip per student will be £33. This covers the purchase of a ticket to the show and transport via coach to and from the theatre. This trip will take place in the evening and students will not be required to wear school uniform. More information about the production can be found at [& Juliet | Official UK Tour Website](#) The parental advisory note states "Age guidance: 8+ with some adult language. Please note that this production features flashing lights and loud noises."

This is a fantastic opportunity to watch live theatre, offering exposure to live music, sound and lighting designing, theatrical acting, vocals and more. This would support student's learning, witnessing firsthand the result of effective dramatic/instrumental/vocal rehearsals through the application of different skills and open curiosity to the different pathways within Performing Arts.

We will be departing from school at 6.15pm, students must arrive by 6.00pm at the latest to be registered ahead of this. We will return to school by 11.00pm and we expect all students to be collected by a parent/carer. Students will be reminded that normal school rules and expectations regarding behaviour and conduct will apply during this trip.

WisePay has been set up with 40 available places for this trip and places will be allocated upon WisePay payment. A waiting list will be held. To confirm a place on the trip for your child a £15 deposit must be made on or before 30<sup>th</sup> January 2025 with a second payment of £18 paid on or before 28<sup>th</sup> February 2025. We understand that the cost of the trip may be a concern for some families. Our school is committed to ensuring that every student has the opportunity to participate, regardless of financial circumstances.
