Re: Year 10 Residential - Barcelona

Dear Parent/Carer,

With the trip to Barcelona fast approaching, this letter outlines the final arrangements and details needed before departure. Please find attached with this letter:

- Behaviour contract to be signed and returned to reception by **Thursday June 27th**.
- Medical Information Form – to be completed and returned to reception **Thursday June 27th**
- Kit List – to advise on luggage restrictions and necessary items.

Final Arrangements

- Departure from the School to the Airport will be 6.15am on Monday July 1st **all students must arrive at the school by 6.00am at the very latest.**
- Students need a breakfast and a packed lunch for the journey or money to purchase food in flight.
- We will travel to East Midlands Airport to board **Ryanair flight 9388 at 9.35am.** Students need to travel light as their bag must comply with airline regulations, as priority boarding passengers students can take 2 bags into the cabin, 1 small bag which fits under the seat in front and the other (55 x 40 x 20cm max 10kg) which can be stored in the overhead locker.
- Liquids - Liquids carried must be in a container of no more than 100ml (3.4 ounces)!. All liquids should be carried in a single, transparent, re-sealable plastic bag of up to 20cm x 20cm with a total capacity of up to a litre.
- You must be able to completely close the bag and be able to fit it in your hand baggage.
- Spending money must be in Euros – we recommend no more than €50.
- Any contact while we are away must go through school reception on 01536 213100. For emergencies call **07860 827 356** – please only use this in an emergency.
- All prescription medication must be clearly labelled and at school reception before **Thursday 27th June** along with the completed medical information form.
- Students do not need sleeping bags or bedding, and towels are also provided..
- Returning from Barcelona Airport on Thursday July 4th by **Ryanair flight 7808 at 19:50** arriving at Luton 21.05. Coach back to school for an approximate arrival time of 10.45pm.
- All updates will be shared on Twitter.

Finally, the itinerary for the trip is below, please ensure that your child is aware of the activities and please use this along with the kit list to help inform packing.

- Activities:
 - Day 1 Afternoon visit to Park Güell

 - Day 3 Morning visit to Montserrat. Afternoon visit to Poble Espanyol
 - Day 4 All day at Port Aventura theme park
