Term 3 has been a busy Term at Corby Technical School. Students have had the opportunity to take part in a number of trips and activities over this term. Progress reports

All students have been given their progress report for the term. Please can all parents/carers return the reply slip by Friday 22nd March 2019.

Swipe cards

All students are issued with a swipe card from school. All students are expected to use their swipe cards. Students will be delayed at reception if they do not have a swipe card as this requires additional administration on the day. If a student has lost their card it is important this card is replaced without delay. This can be paid for on Wisepay.

Attendance

Attendance over this term has shown a decline, largely due to illness. We hope that this improves significantly over Term 4 as we move into Spring. We aim for a minimum of 96.5% attendance for all students. The attendance for your child for this year has been included with your childs' progress report. Punctuality

Please be reminded that students must be here by 8.30am. Students need the opportunity to go to their lockers to prepare themselves for learning.
