Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Year 11 - VCERT Interactive Media

As you are aware your child is studying for a qualification in Interactive media. All students have passed the exam element of the course and work is now underway to complete the four units of controlled assessment that are required to gain the qualification. Students were made aware last term that this work will need to be completed by Friday 21st June. As a school we are currently allowing students to focus on their other GCSE examinations and the school will support students with the completion of their Interactive Media coursework following their final examination.

Consequently all students studying the course will be required to attend school on the following dates to complete their work and will be supported by school staff:

- Monday 17th June (students studying German will attend their exam first)
- Tuesday 18th June
- Wednesday 19th June
- Thursday 20th June
- Friday 21st June.

It is highly unlikely that your child will need all five days as most students are almost complete. During the course of that week we will e-mail you to let you know that your child has completed the work and that they are no longer required to attend the lessons. Students will not be required to wear school uniform on these days and will get a complimentary breakfast and lunch.

The statutory school leaving date for Year 11 students is Friday 28th June so we do not anticipate any issues.
