We are delighted to continue our work with Service Six to keep our students safe online via The Real Time Talk Project. This initiative is being held at Corby Technical School on the 29th and 30th May from 2.00pm to 4.00pm. The first session will involve the Service Six team completing activities with the students, the second session will involve parents/carers and the students working together.

Service Six have received funding from the Northamptonshire Community Foundation from the Making Northamptonshire Safer Communities Fund' to carry out this project.

The TARGET Real Time Talk project, will engage Year 7 students and their parents/carers in ways to prevent dangerous online activities and understand online protective behaviours.

The project will look to reduce incidents of Online Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (OSEA), improve levels of wellbeing, increase knowledge and awareness of OSEA and increase communications and understanding within the home.

Activities will involve students and their parents/carers working together to understand the complexities of being online by unpicking the vulnerabilities towards exploitation grooming and trafficking. Places on this course are limited.
