Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Year 10 Geography Trip - Leicester

A trip has been organised for Year 10 Geography students to complete fieldwork in Leicester City Centre on Tuesday 20th August 2019.

During the trip students will undertake carefully supervised land use maps, pedestrian counts, traffic counts and shop counts in order to complete preparation for one of their 3 GCSE exams in Year 11 which accounts for 30% of their overall final grade. It is essential that all students attend.

Students will travel via coach departing from school at 8.45am (all students must be in school by 8.20am at the very latest) returning at approximately 4.00pm (dependant on traffic).

Students are not expected to wear full uniform, but must dress sensibly, wearing comfortable footwear. Students must be prepared for all weather conditions and are advised to bring a raincoat and sun cream. Students will need to have breakfast before arriving at school and can bring a packed lunch or money to purchase lunch in Leicester. All students must wear their lanyard with their card attached.
