**Re: Year 10 Geography Trip - Hunstanton**

Dear Parent/Carer

A trip has been organised for Year 10 Geography students to complete fieldwork in Hunstanton and Old Hunstanton on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2018.

During the trip students will undertake carefully supervised measurements of longshore drift and the effectiveness of coastal protection in order to complete preparation for one of their 3 GCSE exams in Year 11 which accounts for 30% of their overall final grade.

Students will travel by school minibus departing from school at 8.45am (all students must be in school by 8.15am at the latest) returning at approximately 5.00pm (dependant on traffic). It will therefore be necessary for parents to arrange transport for their child from school at this time.

Students are not expected to wear full uniform, but must dress sensibly, wearing comfortable footwear suitable for spending time on the beach. Students must be prepared for all weather conditions and are advised to bring a raincoat and sun cream. Students are requested to have breakfast before they arrive to school and to have a packed lunch (no glass bottles please) or sufficient money to purchase food and drink. All students must wear their lanyard with their card attached.

There is no charge for this trip. Please give permission for your child to attend via your Wisepay account before Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2019.
