Re: Year 12 Reports

I am pleased to send you the first report for students in Year 12, this gives you information about how students have settled into their course and provides the target grade that students should be working towards, this is an individual target that should be both aspirational and achievable. We have included an attitude to learning grade and teachers have added comments for each subject that students are studying.

I am really proud of how students have settled in to their studies at sixth form, they are an excellent role model for the younger students, students are in a small cohort which is allowing them to have high levels of engagement with subject staff. We have enhanced the curriculum by offering a variety of activities during their IEC sessions; students have benefitted from First Aid Training, Car Craft – an introduction to driving for students, Financial Education as well as a range of webinars from universities and employers. All of these experiences will help to prepare students for their next steps.

One of the big changes for students as they move from studying GCSE's to A levels and other Level 3 qualifications is learning how to manage their time well, students do have self-study periods where they are expected to complete work started in lessons and to read around the subject, teachers are giving clear guidance regarding expectations for this and we continue to support students in making this transition.
