Dear Parents / Carer,

Year 10 Residential – Howtown, Lake District Monday 30th May to Friday 3rd June 2022

I am pleased to inform you that we have the opportunity to take 36 Year 10 students to the Outward-Bound centre in Howtown in the Lake District during term 5.

This a five day (four nights) residential at Howtown which is run by The Outward-Bound Trust, a charity that specialises in developing young people through outdoor adventures. The focus for the course is Personal Development and team building. Students will have the opportunity to take part in a range of activities including; gorge scrambling, rock climbing, abseiling, an overnight camp in the wilderness, canoeing and kayaking. By stepping outside their comfort zone, students will discover new strengths and skills. They will also develop confidence and trust within their group, which has a positive effect back in the classroom.

I am writing to you now with the details so that you can plan ahead, please note that the last two days of the residential are Bank Holidays, so please check that students are able to attend on those dates:

- Dates Monday 30th May 2022 to Friday 3rd June 2022
- Cost £410 – payment to be made through WISEPAY – details to follow
- Venue, Outward Bound Centre, Howtown, Lake District
- Activities; Day 1 Travel to Howtown, evening activities
Day 2 - 4 Activities both on site and in the local area including an overnight camp
Day 5 Morning activities, lunch then return to Corby Technical School
