Re: Year 11 Prom

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to inform you our Year 11 Prom will be held on Tuesday 28th June 2022 at Corby Technical School. This is an exciting event for our Year 11 students marking the end of the GCSE exam period, and for some students, the end of their journey with us here at Corby Technical School. The Prom will be a celebration of the students' achievements over their time at the school as well as giving them a chance to enjoy being together as a cohort with some of their teachers for one last time.

The evening will begin with arrivals from 6.30pm and will consist of a formal meal which will be served at 7.15pm followed by a disco and karaoke. We will also provide a photobooth for students as well as the opportunity for formal photographs. We anticipate the evening will end at approximately 10.30pm. We have been working with the Prom committee made up of representatives from each tutor group to ensure that we are providing a suitable celebration for our students at the end of Year 11. The price of tickets will be £40, and payment must be made through Wisepay. A non-refundable deposit of £20 on or before Friday 29th April is required to secure a place, with full payment to be paid by Friday 10th June 2022 for all students attending.

Our students have been a fantastic cohort who have grown and matured over their time with us. We have been particularly proud of year 11 students this year, presenting as extremely focused as they head into the examination period. We have seen very few incidents of poor behaviour, however, should a student have significant poor behaviour prior to the Prom this may put their admission to the event at risk. Equally, it is important to note that if behaviour on the evening falls below our expectation, this will result in a student being asked to leave. We would also like to highlight that strictly no alcohol must be brought onto the school site and any students who appear under the influence will not be admitted. These conditions do not go beyond our typical school expectations, and therefore, they should not present a challenge for any student. As a school, we will be looking forward to celebrating this event with <u>all</u> students who wish to attend.

We would like to be able to share photographs after the Prom, so that all students have the chance to remember the evening. The most efficient way to do this, would be for us to upload the photographs into a shared folder online, and give students a link to access this. We would also like to share some of our photographs with our school community via social media. For this reason, we will require consent from you for your child's photographs to be included in this folder. We would like to make you aware that if you do not give consent for your child to be included in these photographs, they may be asked to sit out of any group photographs being taken on the evening to allow others to have photos shared.

We want this to be a fabulous event to celebrate Year 11 and there will be lots to do on the day to transform the George Weston Theatre into a beautiful venue. If any of our Year 11 parents are able to offer their support on the day to set up for the event, please contact Mrs Smith, your support will be greatly appreciated.
