Many of you would have seen in the local press recently, the appeal from a local family in need of support for some lifesaving treatment for their child. Florence Bark, who is a Year 1 student at Oakley Vale Primary in Corby, has recently been diagnosed with acute myeloid leukemia (AML), a form of blood cancer, and is in urgent need of a stem cell transplant.
