## Uniform Expectations

Dear Parents/Carers,

At Corby Technical School, we have high expectations regarding school uniform. Due to the current high temperatures, we are making adaptations that enable students to remove their blazers in lessons. Decisions are made on a daily basis in line with the weather and students are informed of these during tutor time first thing in the morning. We are not always in a position to inform parents beforehand unless we are expecting a prolonged period of hot weather. I am pleased to say that our students have behaved extremely responsibly with this expectation.

One aspect of our uniform expectation that we require further support from parents/carers with is with students who wear skirts to school. Our expectations are that that skirts must sit at the knee and be of a formal style, not a tube or other tight-fitting skirt. This has always been a part of our uniform policy however, despite this, we are experiencing an increase in the number of students wearing skirts that do not meet these expectations.

We would ask parents/carers to check your child's uniform to ensure this is appropriate and to avoid your child being sanctioned for not meeting these expectations. Can we also remind all parents/carers that students are expected to wear black shoes and trainers are not permitted.

May I take this opportunity to thank parents/carers who ensure their child comes into school in full school uniform and appropriate sports kit on a consistent basis. Following this letter, contact will only be made with parents/carers of students who are not wearing the correct uniform.
